It had to be heard to be believed - done with 'accomplished skill'.

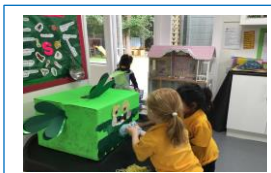
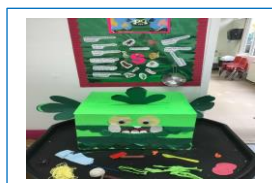
