

Dear Parents

The O2 Young Voices concert is on Monday 4th February. We will take the children up to the O2 arena after an early lunch where we will take part in a whole choir rehearsal before the concert. The concert begins at 7.00pm and will finish at approximately 9.15pm. Below we set out the arrangements and information for this event:

Travelling to the O2

We will leave St David's in time to catch the 12.25pm train from West Wickham to London Bridge and then take the Jubilee Line to North Greenwich

Food

All the children will need a packed tea including water or cartons of juice (no fizzy drinks) and snacks to last the afternoon/evening. Please bring this in a small rucksack. They will not need any money but may like to bring a small paperback book, comic or Top Trumps type game to play while waiting for the concert to start.

Charity

We would like the children to bring **ONE** tin of food to the concert. FareShare, the national award winning charity, will then collect the food and distribute the items to the homeless.

Dress

The children **MUST** wear their official Young Voices t-shirt with plain dark skirt or trousers (jeans are only acceptable if they are smart and black or very dark blue). So that the t-shirt remains clean before we leave please send your child in wearing their school polo shirt and sweatshirt with the skirt or trousers that they will be wearing for the concert. They can change before we leave. Outerwear must be the school waterproof coat and school gloves, hats and scarves.

Tickets

Your audience tickets have also been given out today. No video or SLR cameras are allowed into the arena and we have been advised to tell you that any equipment will be confiscated. Programmes will be available to purchase on the night.

 You may like to bring binoculars so that you can see the children and there is a 'Young Voices' app you may like to download but not sure how successful it will be!

leave in stages. We have arranged to meet at the last advertising pillar, near to the O2 pier entrance (see attached google earth photo). You turn left out of the main O2 building.


