



Bromley Primary Schools' Cross-Country Races

Dear Parents,

Please find attached the information for the Bromley Primary Schools' Cross-Country competition which will be taking place on Saturday 9th March. Please read through the letter carefully and should you have any questions please do not hesitate to contact Mr Hunter via the school office.

Date: **Saturday 9th March 2019**

Venue: **Crystal Palace Park**

1. **Marshals** – If you have volunteered as a marshal, please report to the announcing desk at **08:40** a.m., at which time you will be placed on the course. All marshals will be given a special bib to wear. Marshals must stay at their post for ALL races.
2. **Runners** - All runners are to report to **Mr Hunter** on the Upper Terraces at Stake #19 by **09.00 a.m at the latest.**
3. **Dress** - Children are to wear their St David's Prep Navy PE kit and trainers. We recommend that they also bring with them their school tracksuit, school waterproof coat and scarves, gloves, etc to wear when not running. You may want to considering bringing a waterproof bag in which to keep their items in when they are running.

N.B. **Asthmatics** *must* carry their inhalers (named) with them when running.
No spikes or football boots are allowed.

4. **Car Parking** – parking can be difficult. We suggest that you think about where you will park beforehand (for example side roads or Crystal Palace car park). Please allow yourselves plenty of time to find a parking space and to arrive at the upper terrace.
5. **Presentation** - presentation of awards will occur at approximately 11.00 a.m.

N.B. **No child should leave without first informing Mr Hunter or a member of St David's Staff**

Finally, we suggest that you bring refreshments for the morning and plenty of water for your child. There is normally a concession van near the steps to the meeting/assembly point.
