controlled and varied without being overly-dramatic'.*

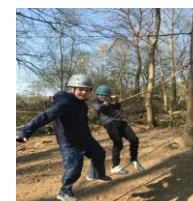

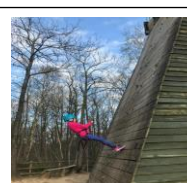
ECO-COMMITTEE
