We are aiming for over 200 stories to be shared, and would very much appreciate your support with this at home. Over half term, we would like all the children to take a photograph of themselves sharing stories. They can share with a friend or a sibling, an adult or even their pet. We would like them to take a photograph of themselves reading with someone, which we can then display around the school. You can either print the photo out and send it in with them after half term, or email it to me at holly.bishop@stdavidsprep.com. Every photo received will earn a sticker to give us a head start on our challenge.

In addition to this, children are also invited to participate in two other World Book Day events, both taking place on Thursday 5th March. Firstly, in order to get into the spirit of the day, we would like very child in our school to dress in the costume of their favourite storybook character and to bring the book with that character into school to share with their classmates. Secondly, we will be holding our first 'Bishop's Bookstall Bonanza'. Children are invited to bring in to school books they have read at home and enjoyed, but would like to swap with another child. Over the course of the morning, all children will have the opportunity to browse the donated books and to select a book to take home and read. If they do not have books to bring in, they can bring in a 50p donation. All proceeds and left-over books at the end of the day will be donated to Book Aid International.
