Staff at St David's Prep acknowledge that parents and family are integral to a child's life and early learning experiences. We recognise parents as key educators and aim to work in partnership with parents

We can do this by: -

- Sharing information on entry about your child's previous experiences, achievements, likes and dislikes.
- Building on and developing what your child has learned at home or in previous Early Year's establishments.
- Providing opportunities for parents to share skills and knowledge with the children and staff.
- Enlisting the help of parents for outings, fundraising activities etc.
- Providing an end of year report.
- Reporting to parents on a regular basis via Class Dojo.
- Informal day to day contact.
- Access to 'Tapestry' and online learning journal where parents are able to track their child's learning and add their own observations.
- Formal meetings at Parent's Evenings in the autumn and spring terms.
- Open evening at the end of the summer term.
- Working together to promote positive behaviour by encouraging the children to consider the needs of others and to develop self esteem.
